Second Group...7/16" group.



Third Group...slightly over a half inch group.



Fourth Group...9/16" group.



Fifth Group...I pulled the last shot. The 4 shots measure 5/16".



Sixth Group...I decided to go for 10 shots. I blew the first shot, but the next 9 shots were just a hair over .5".

All groups were shot at 50yards from a rest, no machine was used. The groups were measured from edge to edge not center to center. Actual groups are .22 smaller. The X-Ring functioned flawlessly with Wolf ammo. The Whistlepig barrel is quite impressive. I used a brick of ammo and the better part of 8 hours at the range. I am confident the rifle is capable of shooting even better than you see in the test.
